

Mission/Outreach Requirements

You must attend 3 of the following:

If you already attended either the Free Garage sale Oct. 24, 2009 or free Christmas wrapping Dec. 2009, then you can count them towards your three requirements

1. Grocery box preparation – Friday, February 26th 4 - 6 pm
2. “Yard Clean Up” day (also a fundraiser) - April 17th, 9 am - 1 pm
3. Free Garage Sale - June 12th, 6 am - 11 am
4. Volunteer at Harvest Ministries
(Monday - Thursday 8:30 - 11:30 *any day* May 24th - June 10th)

Additional requirements: (all are mandatory)

1. Help at least 3 days of VBS June 14th - 18th
2. Attend all fundraiser luncheons (which include a group meeting)
 - a. Feb. 28th
 - b. March 28th
 - c. May 2nd

*All luncheons will require setup, serving, clean-up, and tear down.

Ministry Requirements

All students are required to commit the “Romans Road” to memorization and explain it.

All scripture below is from the NIV

1. *Everyone needs salvation because we have all sinned.*

Romans 3:10-12 “As it is written: “There is no one righteous, not even one; there is no one who understands, no one who seeks God. All have turned away, they have together become worthless; there is no one who does good, not even one.”

Romans 3:23 “for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God”

2. *The price (or consequence) of sin is death.*

Romans 6:23 “For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

3. *Jesus Christ died for our sins. He paid the price for our death.*

Romans 5:8 “But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”

4. *We receive salvation and eternal life through faith in Jesus Christ.*

Romans 10:9-10 “That if you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.”

Romans 10:13 “for, ‘Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.’”

5. *Salvation through Jesus Christ brings us into a relationship of peace with God.*

Romans 5:1 “Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,”

Romans 8:1 “Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus,”

Romans 8:38-39 “For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

We will also have several skits for our students to do.

Fundraisers

Luncheons

All luncheons will be held in the youth center at Christ's Church and will follow Sunday morning church service. Everyone will be required to come and set up, serve, clean up, and tear down. All money brought in from the fundraiser will be split equally among the students. Dates for the luncheons is as follows:

- Feb. 28th
- March 28th
- May 2nd

Yard Clean-up Sponsorship

Our yard clean-up sponsorship will be a day in which we choose a neighborhood in Roswell where we will do various tasks such as; raking and cleaning up yards, painting fences, or whatever needs done. This sponsorship will work much like a marathon in that you will raise money by having friends and family sponsor you "per hour" of work. We will work for four hours.

For ex: someone may sponsor you for \$5 an hour x 4 hours = \$20. The goal would be to get as many people sponsoring you as possible.

The date for this sponsorship will be **April 17th - 9:00 am – 1:00 pm**

We will provide you with sponsorship forms several weeks in advance.

Rent-A-Teen

Rent-A-Teen is another option that we will have available the last week of May and the first two weeks of June. This will be an opportunity for the church to rent a teenager for some manual labor. Recommended amount is \$50 for 3 hours (1/2 day) or \$100 for 6 hours (full day). This is not a required fundraiser.

Letter Writing

Sending our letters to family and friends is a great way for those who cannot go on the trip to be involved by supporting you. I **highly encourage** you to send out a lot of letters. There are many people who would love to go on a mission trip but cannot for various reasons but can pray for and financially support you on your mission.
